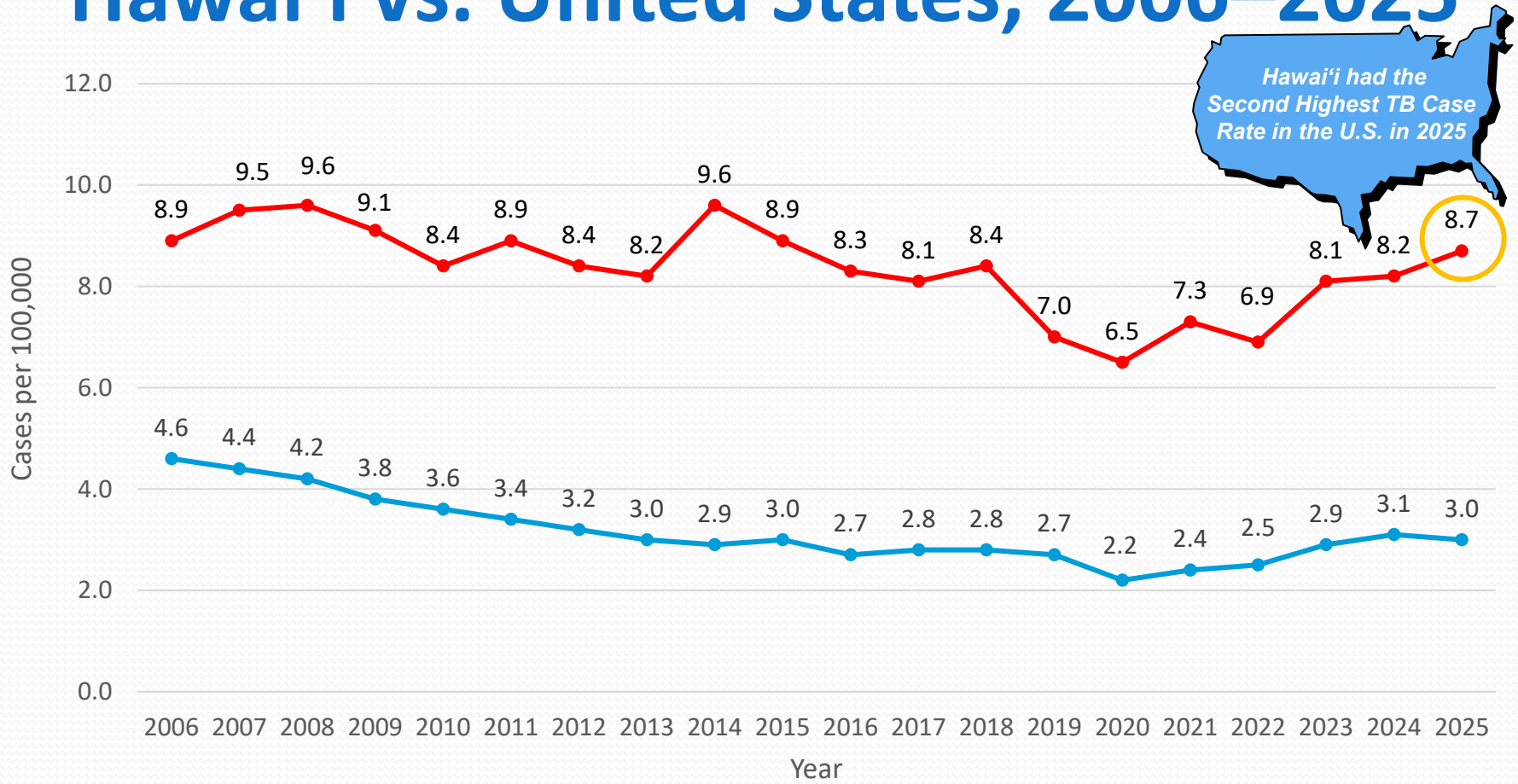

## Hawai'i vs. United States, 2006–2025

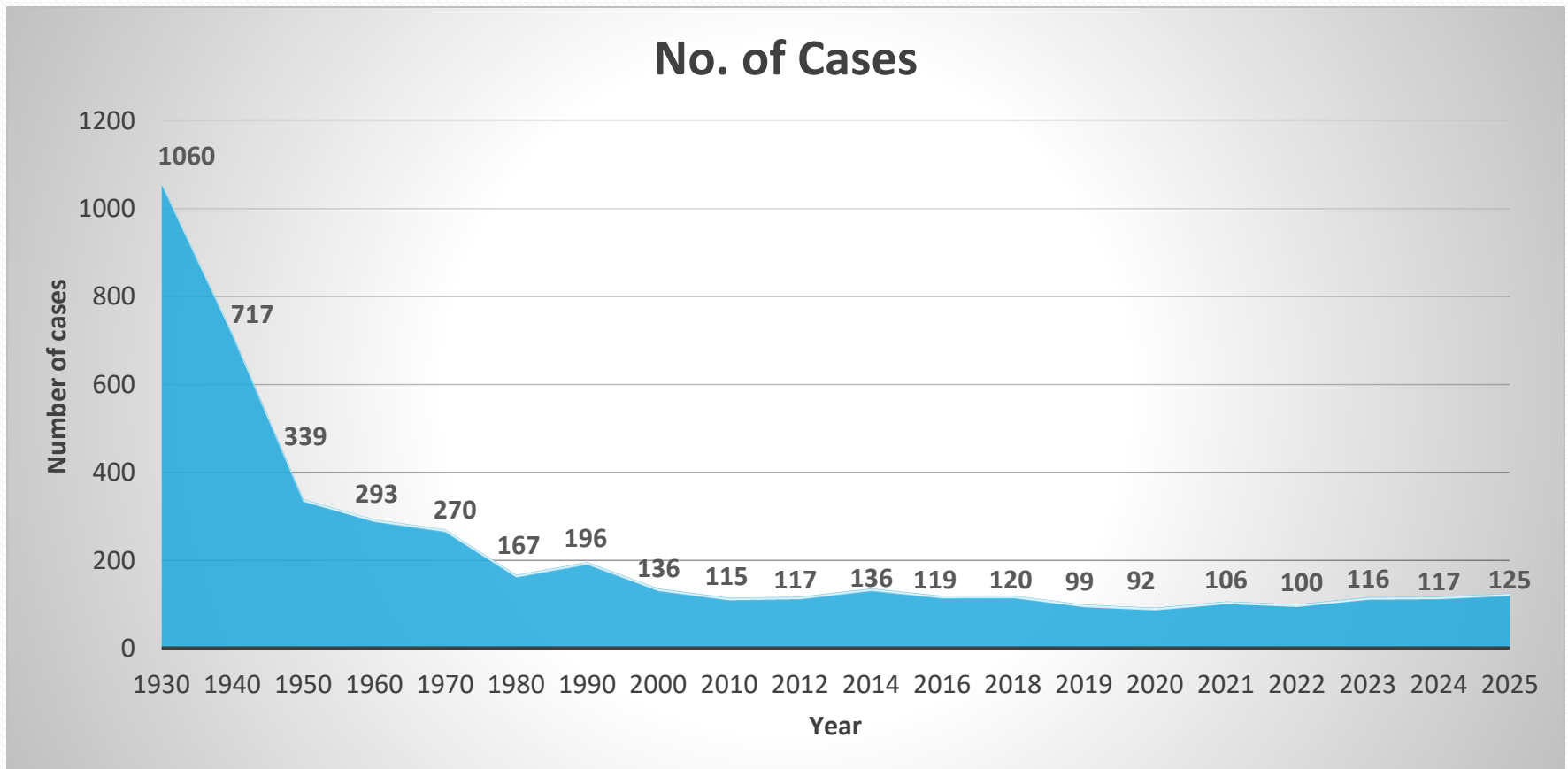

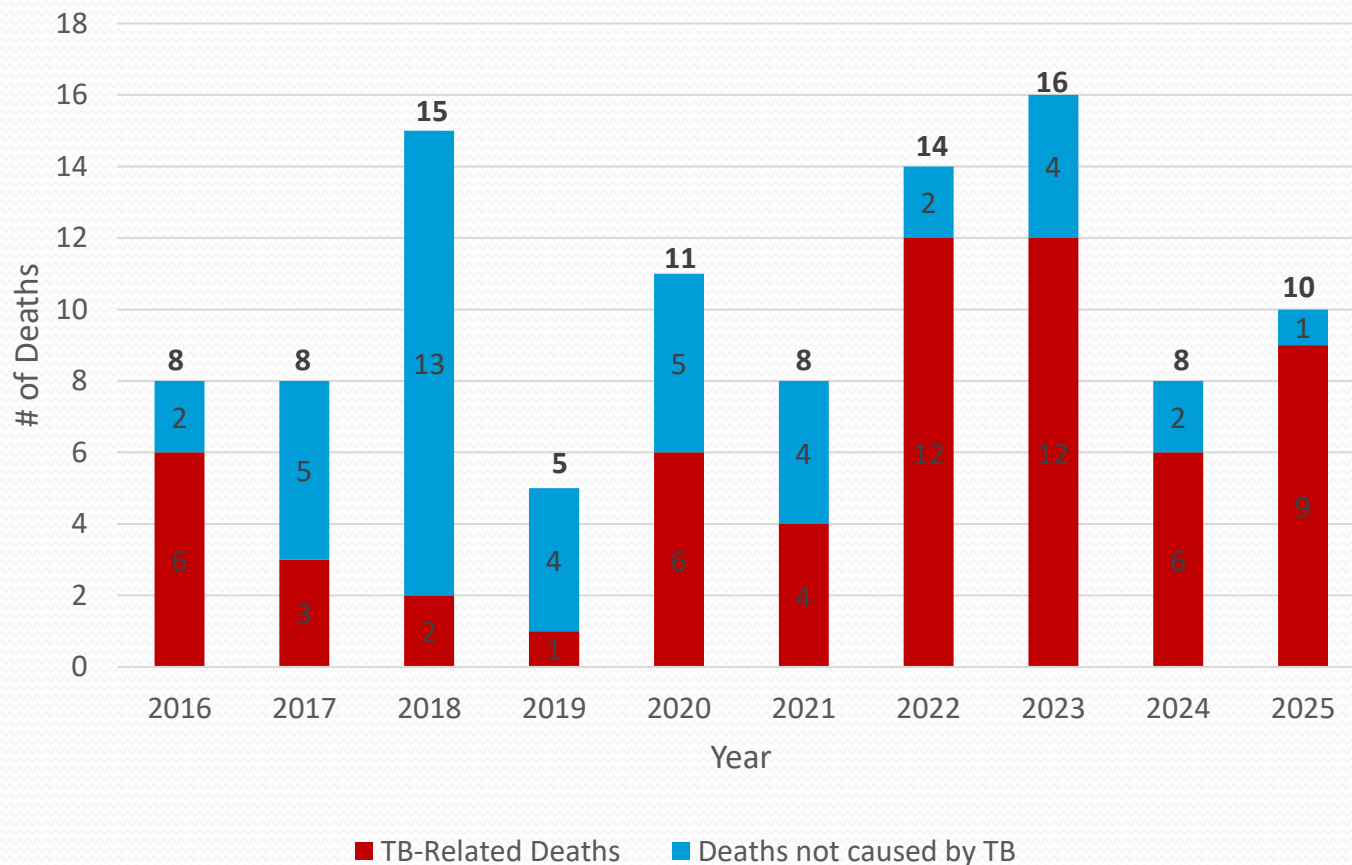

# Hawai'i TB Case Deaths, 2016–2025



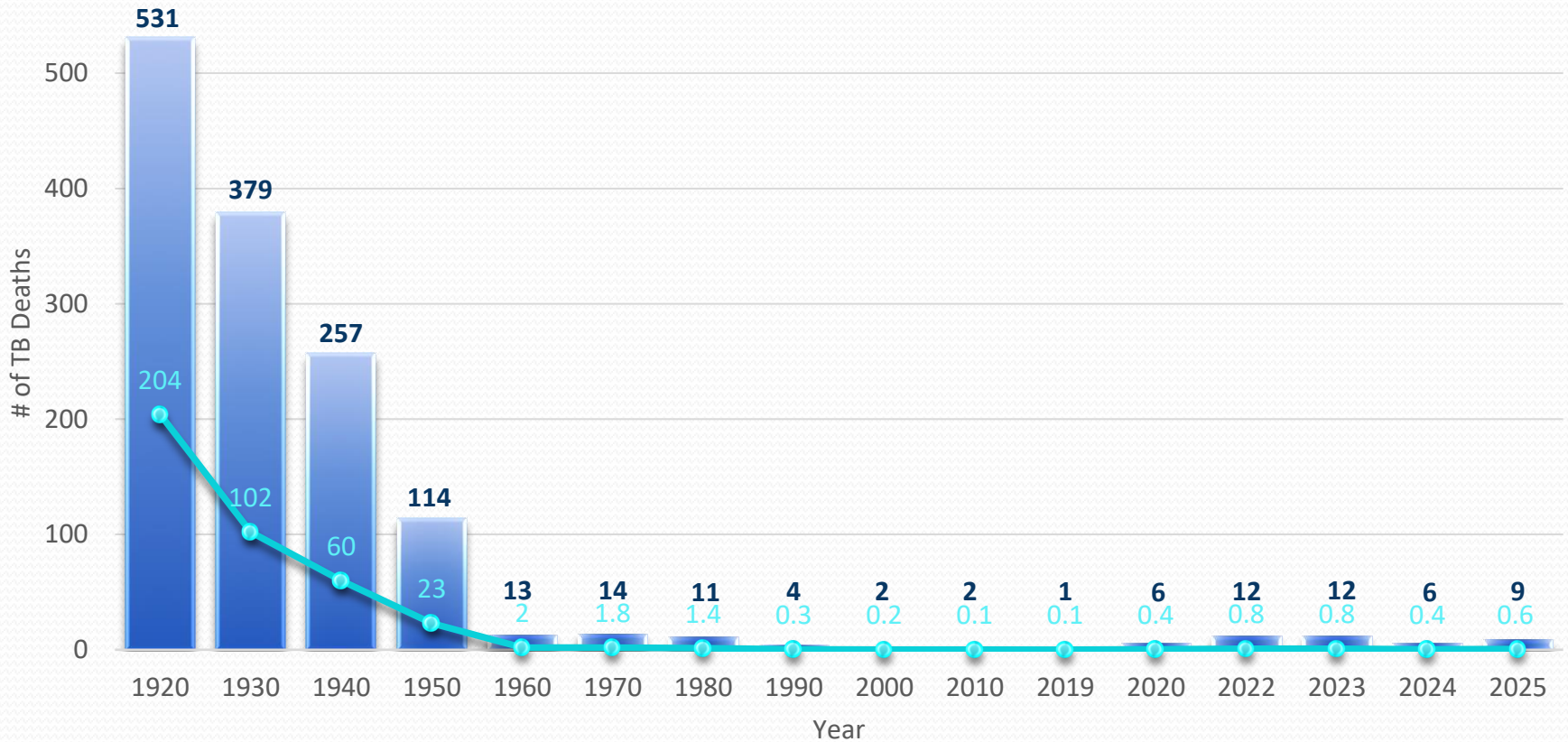

■ TB Deaths    ● TB Death Rate (per 100,000)

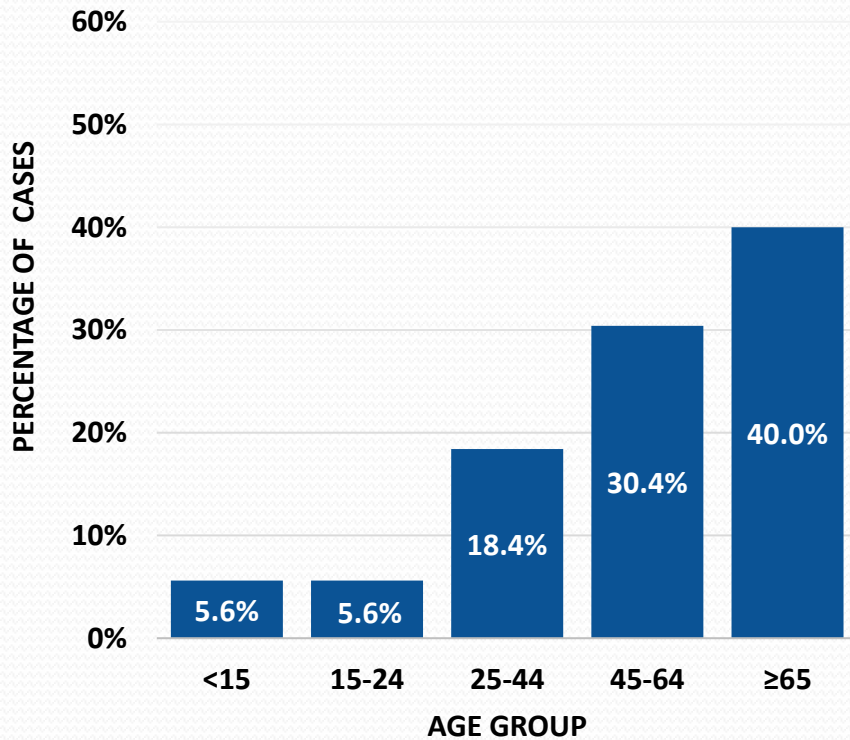

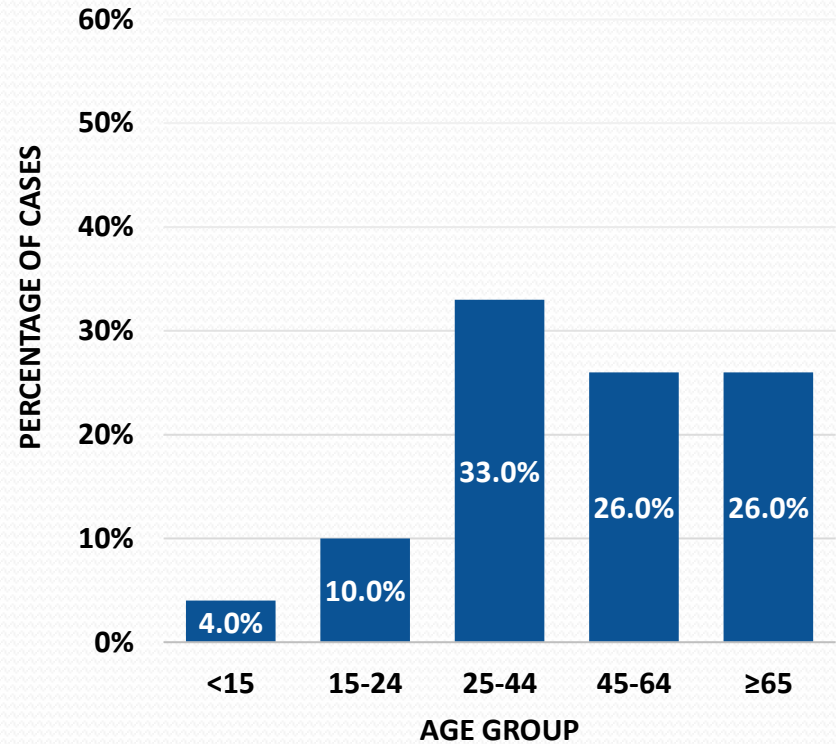


# Percent of TB Cases by Age Group Hawai'i vs. United States, 2025

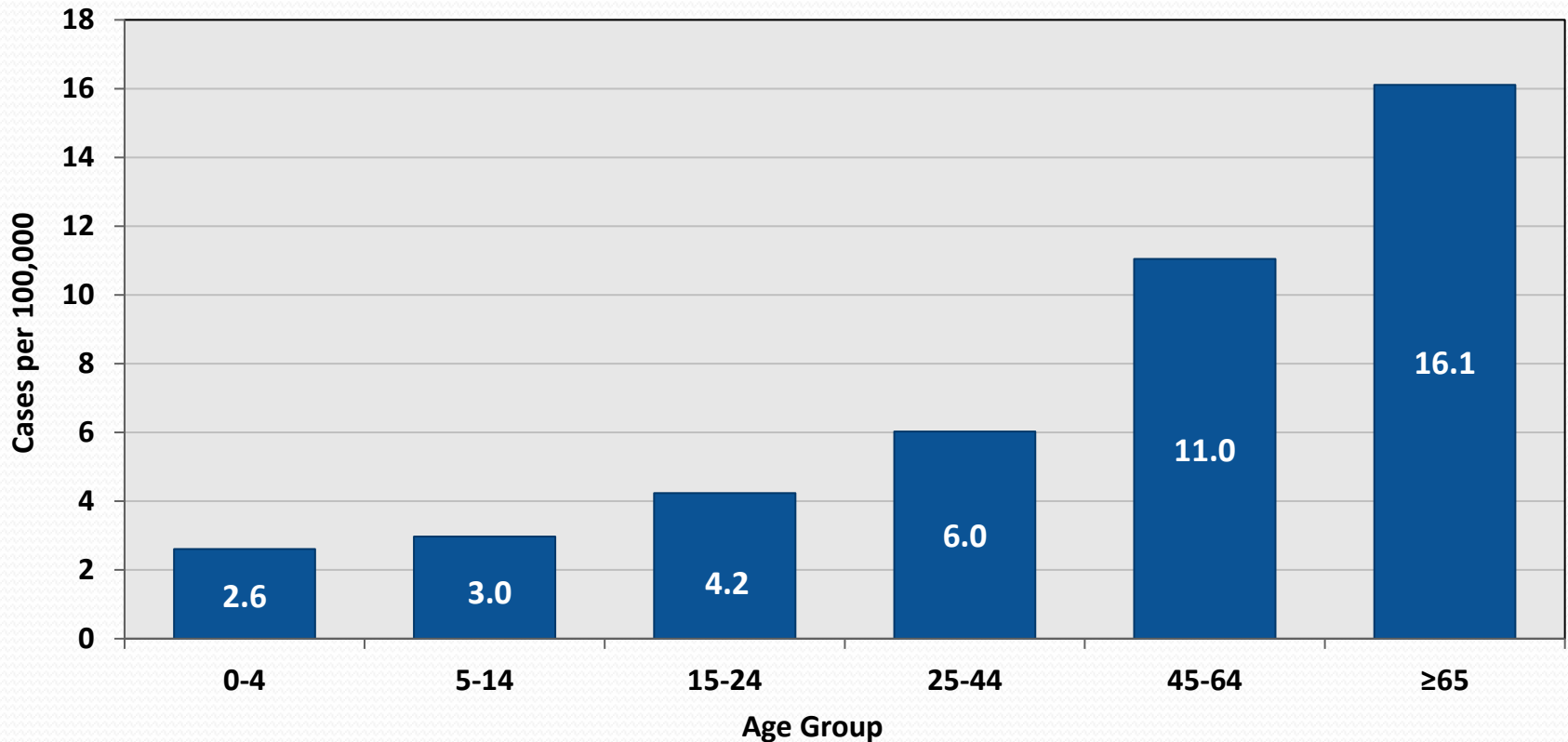

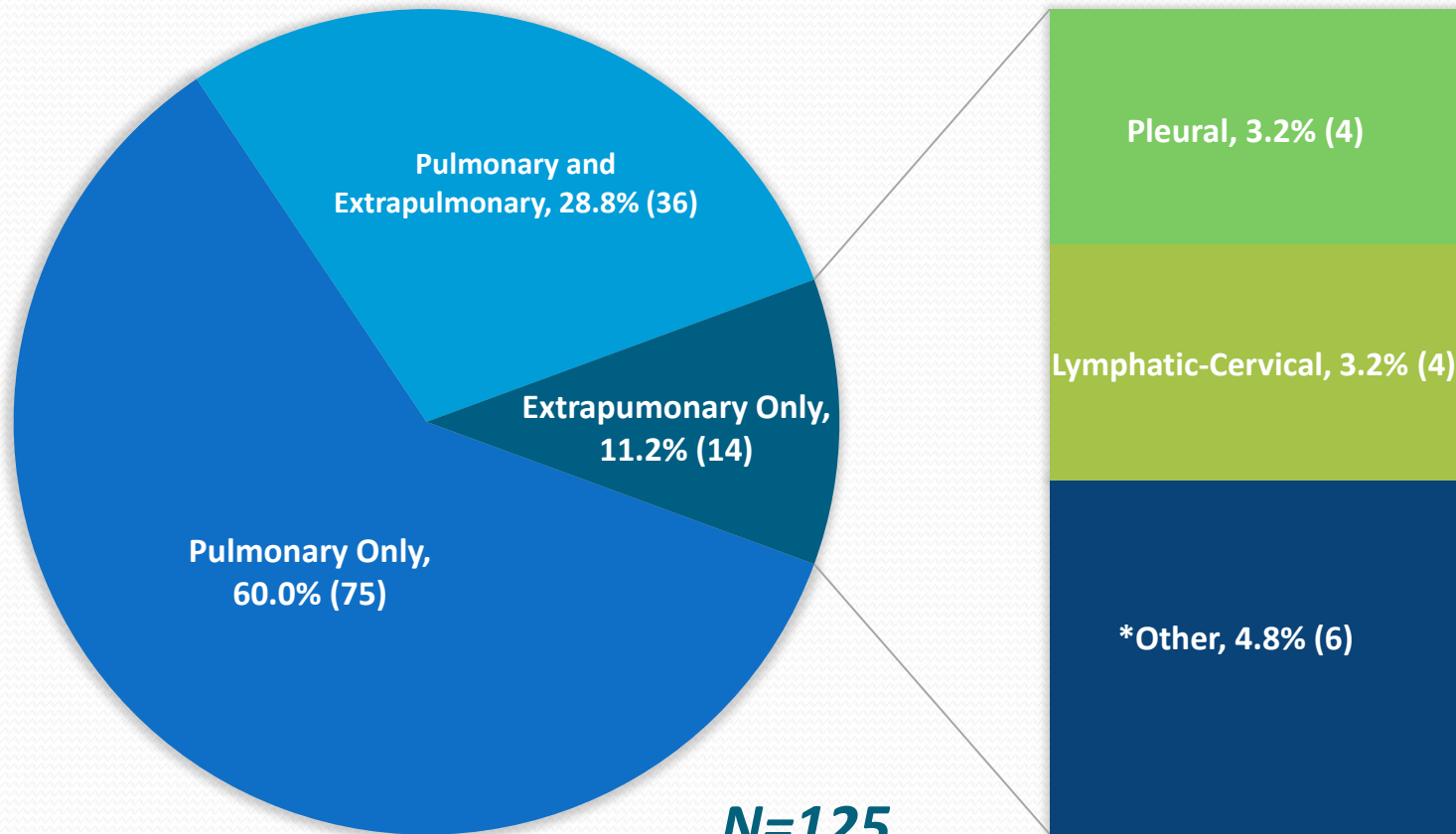

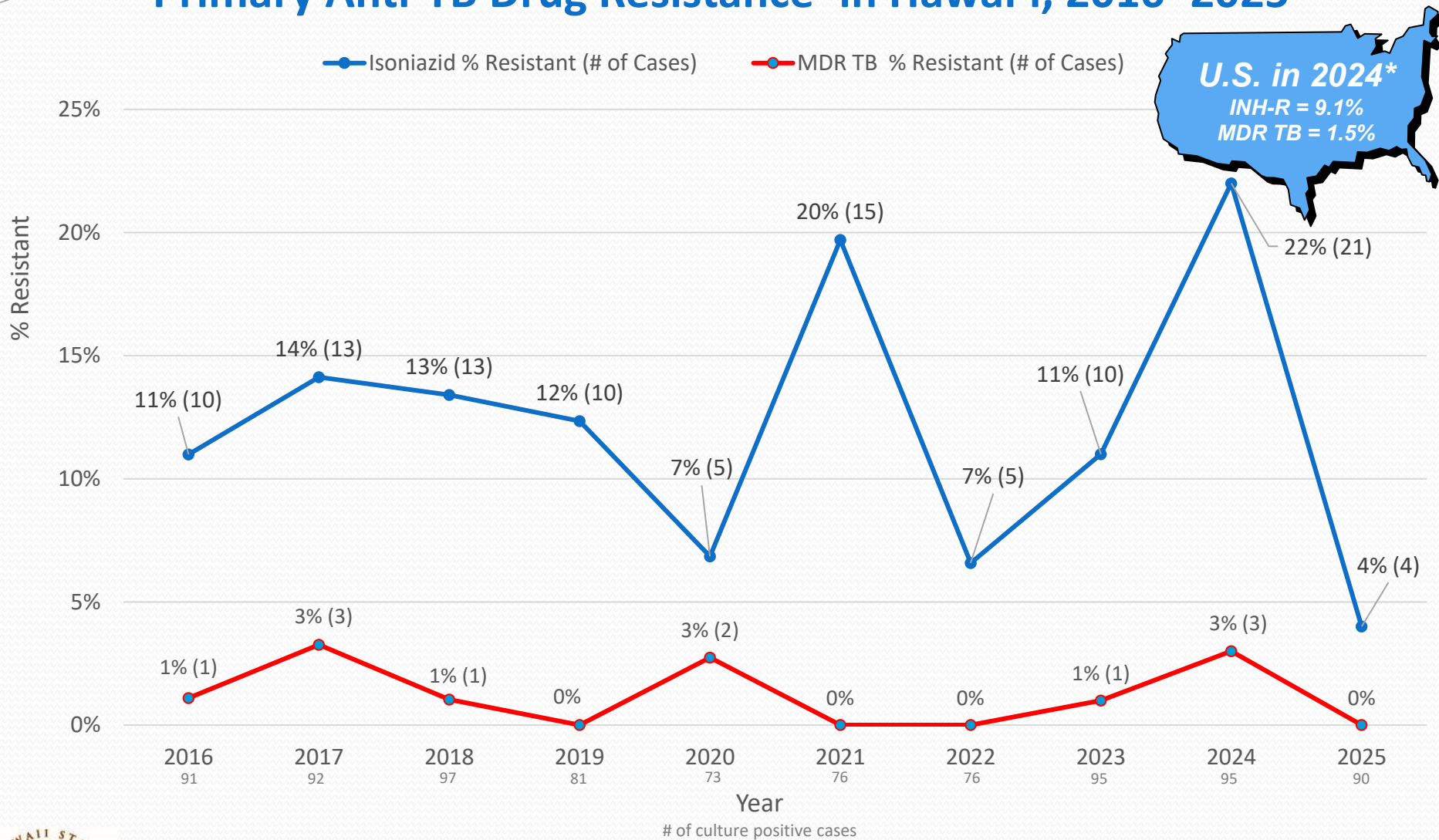
# TB Cases by Major Site of Disease Hawaii, 2025

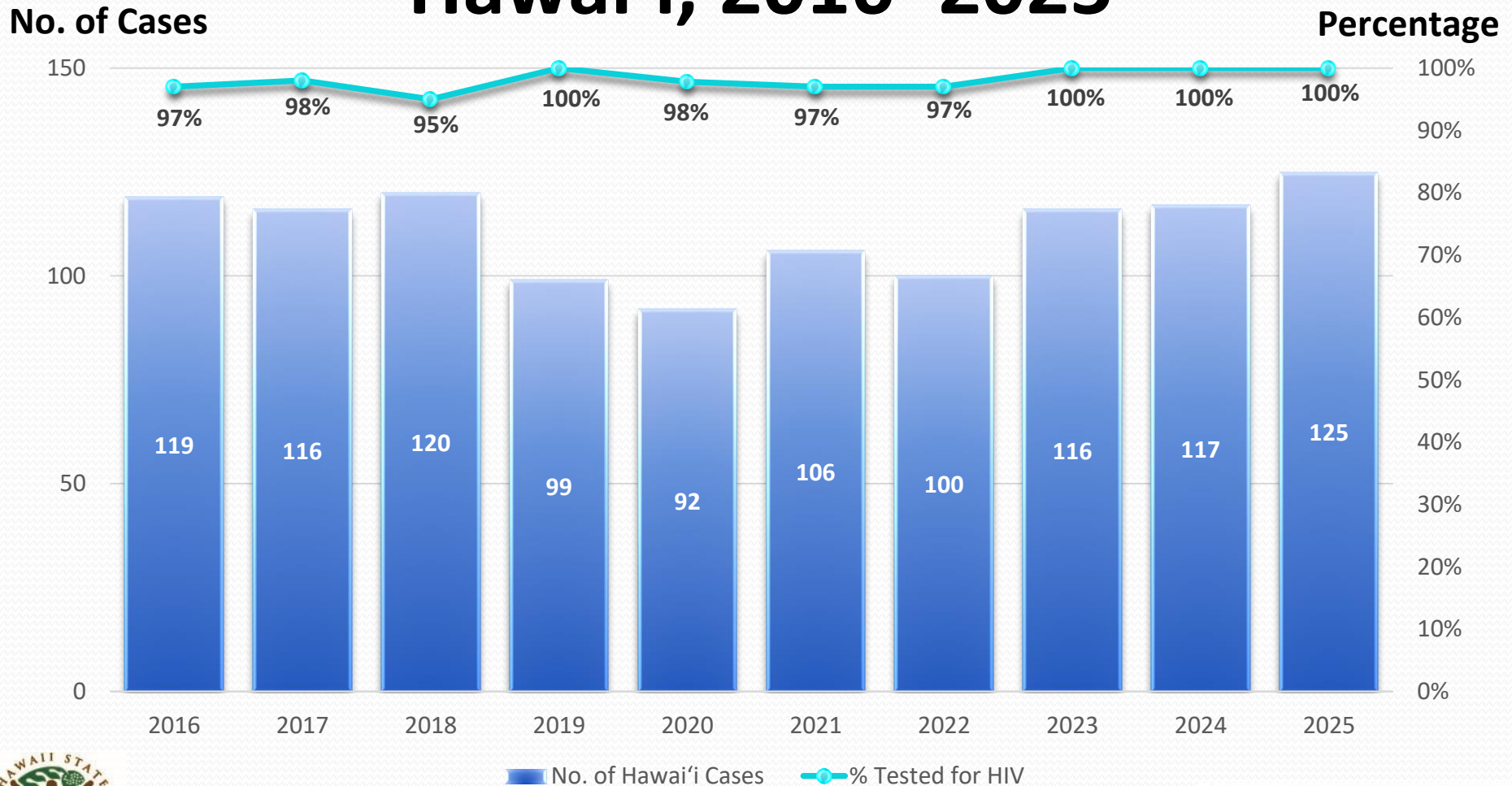

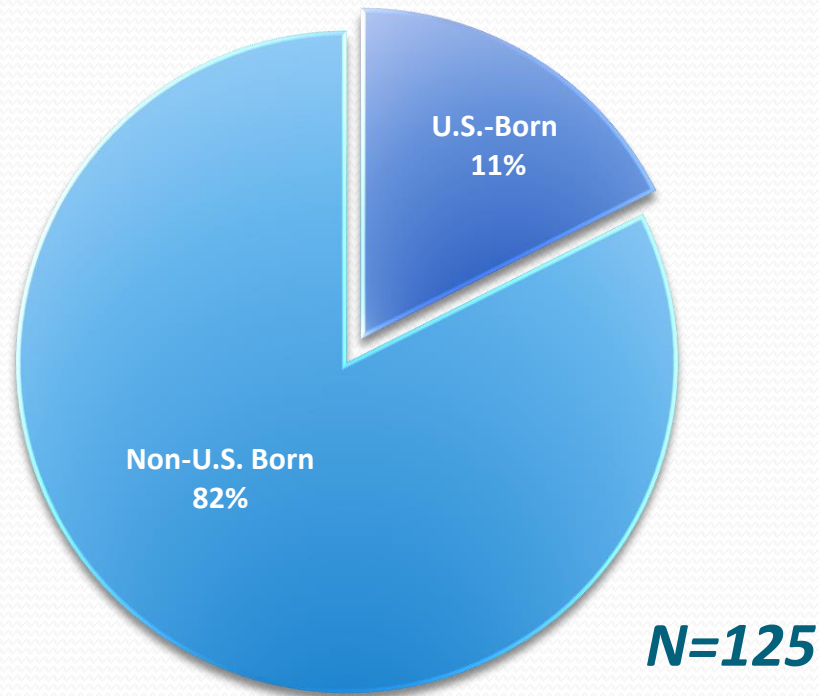

# U.S. & Non-U.S. Born Status of All Persons Reported with TB, Hawai'i, 2025



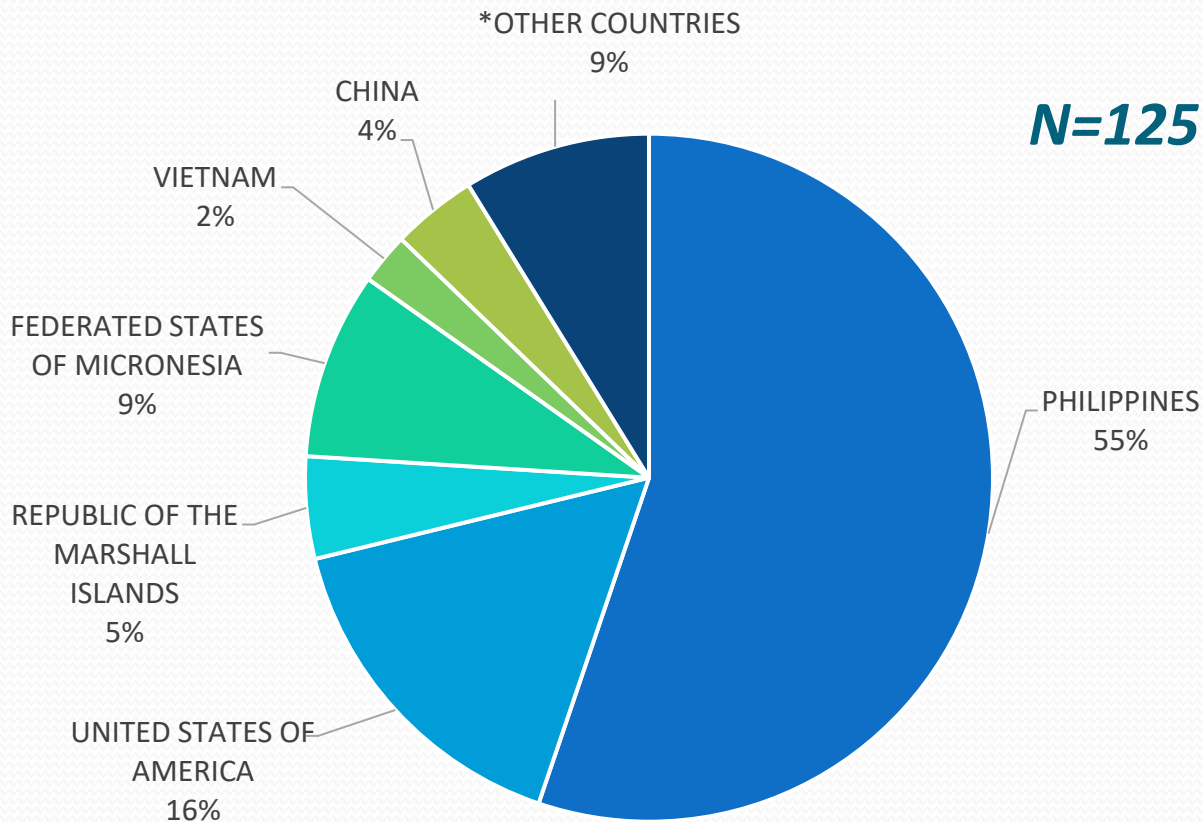

# Countries of Birth for All Persons Reported with TB, Hawai'i, 2025



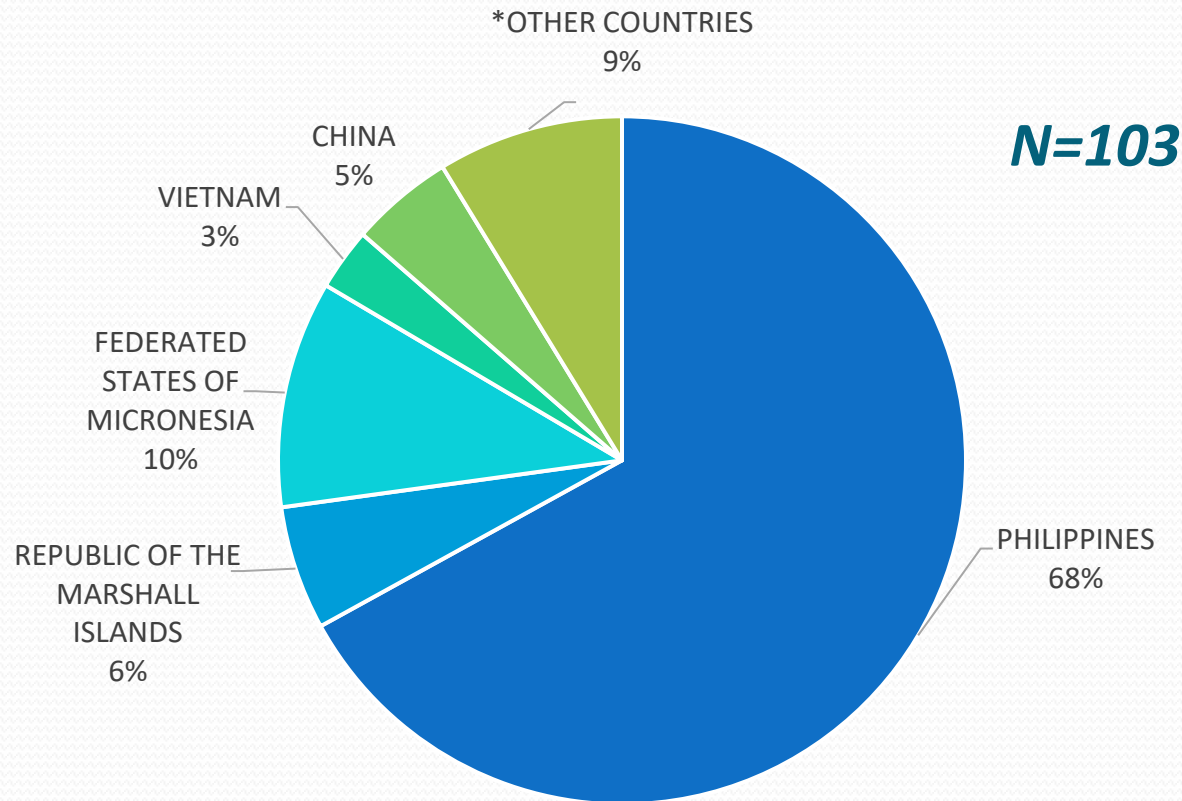

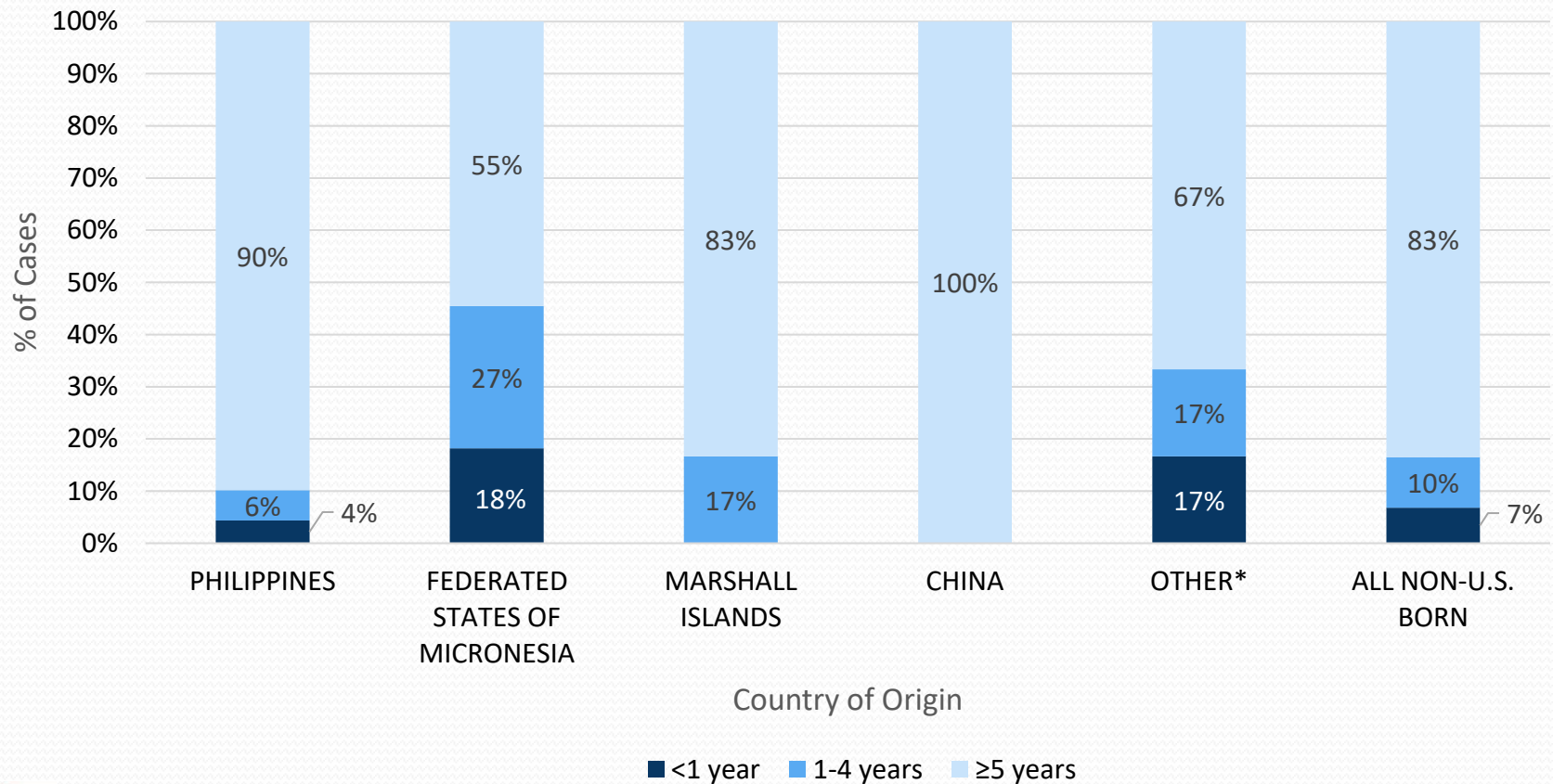
