As reported originally to the DOH-Hazard Evaluation and Emergency Response (HEER) Office on March 17, 2020 and June 2, 2020, there was a release of oil to surface water at Hotel Pier. The Navy has undertaken on-going response actions to locate and secure the source of the release; while containing and recovering product. All response actions have been fully coordinated with DOH and United States Coast Guard. The Navy will continue to collaborate with DOH as the site transitions from emergency response phase.

In response to DOH letter U0711HM of June 30, 2021, the Navy is submitting a Confirmed Release Notification Form as Enclosure 1. The Navy will follow the timelines identified in the June 30, 2021 letter, beginning today.
