3. Track participants' health status over time and gather information on how fuel exposures may impact health



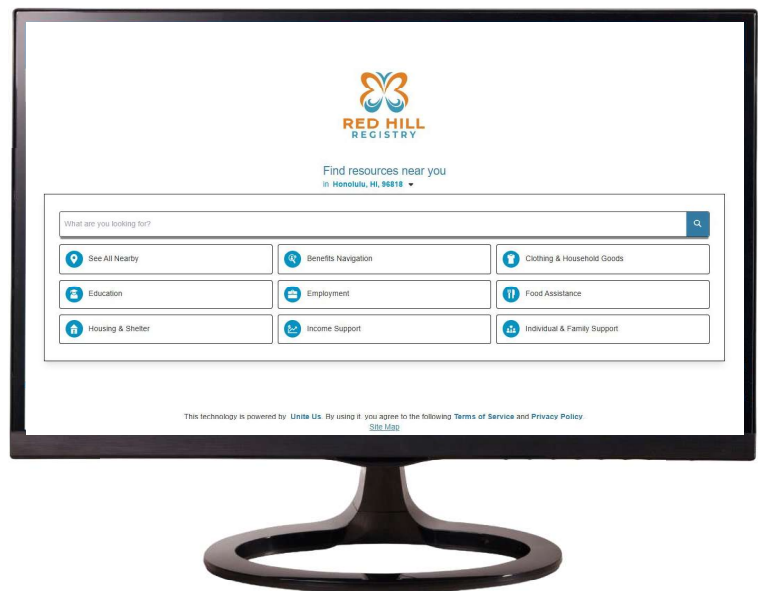

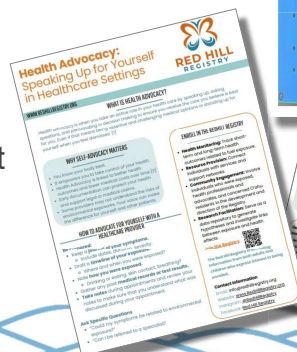
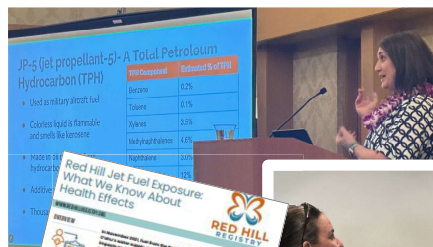

Pre-Enrollment

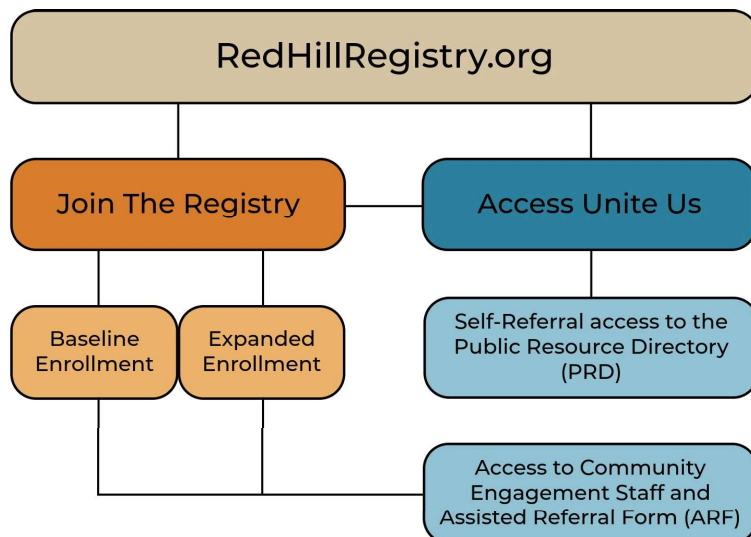
Baseline Enrollment:

- Individuals who were exposed to jet fuel-contaminated water between 11/20/2021- 3/18/2022

Expanded Enrollment:

- On Navy waterline before and/or after 11/20/2021- 3/18/2022
- Immediate area surrounding the Navy water line
- Unexposed housemates of exposed individuals

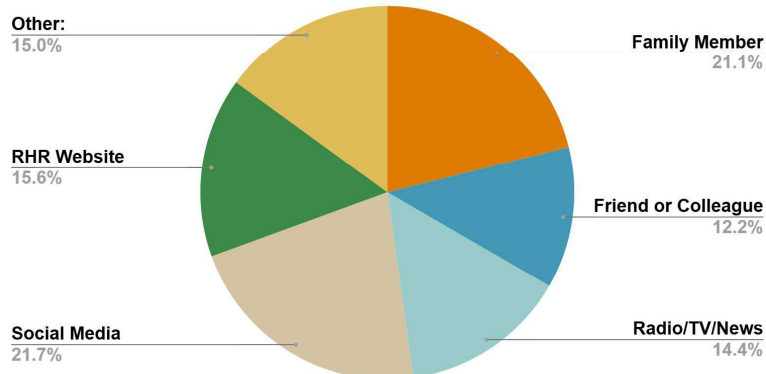
