Kipapa:

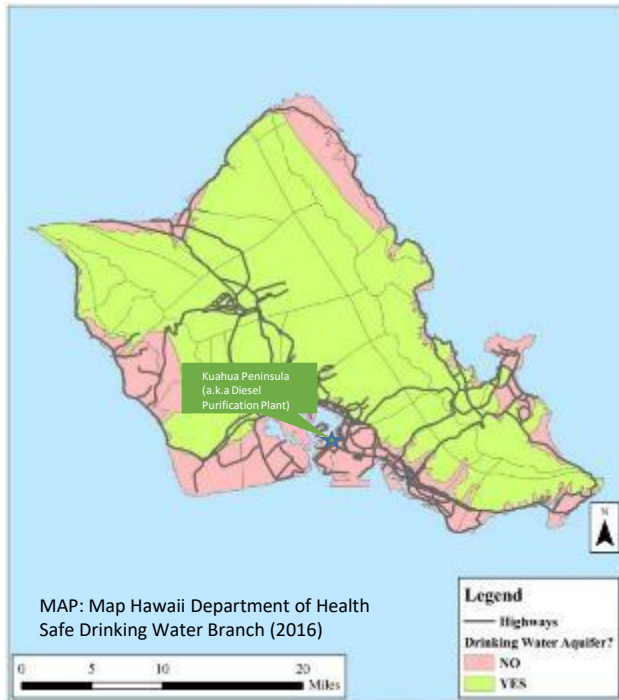
- Tanks Permanently Out of Use
- A Response Action Memorandum/ Decision Document was approved and signed by DOH on 3 Feb 2012
- Remedy included long-term monitoring, land use controls, lead-impacted soil excavation, and bioventing
- Annual groundwater monitoring continues

Waikakalaua:

- Tanks Permanently Out of Use
- A Record of Decision was approved and signed by DOH on 19 Oct 2009 with a no further action decision



Kuahua Peninsula (a.k.a Diesel Purification Plant)



Kuahua:

- Contract to empty, clean, cap, and secure eight USTs concluded in 2021
 - 5 UST temporarily closed
 - 3 USTs storing infiltration water
- Ongoing discussions with DOH on long-term closure of the facility including the pipelines
 - Data gathering for DOH-requested data is underway
 - Data and DOH engagement will shape the closure work plan



Pacific Missile Range Facility



PMRF:

- Five tanks removed from service between 2019 to 2023 due to reduced requirement for operational storage
- Four tanks currently in use continue to successfully pass monthly release detection evaluation
- Plans to replace the tanks with Aboveground Storage Tanks
