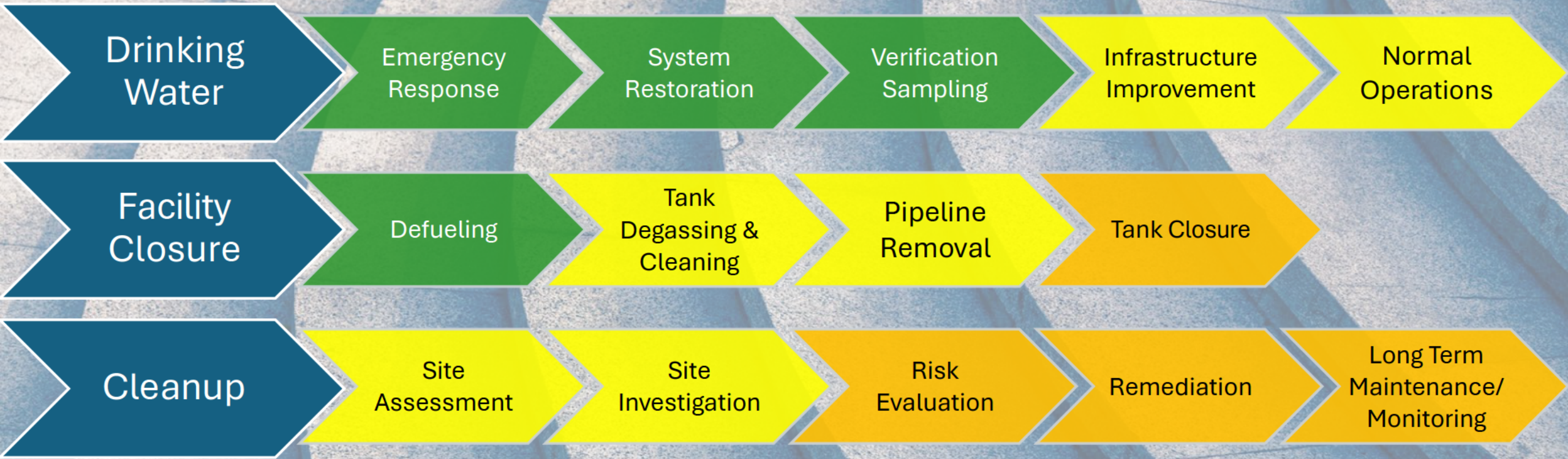

How do the Regulators Regulate Red Hill?

- **Underground Storage Tank Cleanup/Closure (Fuel)**
 - DOH - 2022 Emergency Order and Hawai'i Administrative Rules
 - EPA - 2023 Administrative Consent Order (ACO)
- **Drinking Water System**
 - DOH - Hawai'i Administrative Rules
 - EPA – ACO and Safe Drinking Water Act
- **PFAS**
 - DOH/ EPA - Superfund/Federal Facilities Agreement





EPA Drinking Water Assessment Update

- EPA's Drinking Water Assessment Report published on March 31, 2026.
- EPA concludes there is no evidence of residual fuel, or other fuel-related contaminants, in the JBPHH and AMR public water systems following the impacts from the November 2021 fuel release.
- EPA supports the public water systems' return to routine drinking water compliance monitoring under the supervision of DOH.

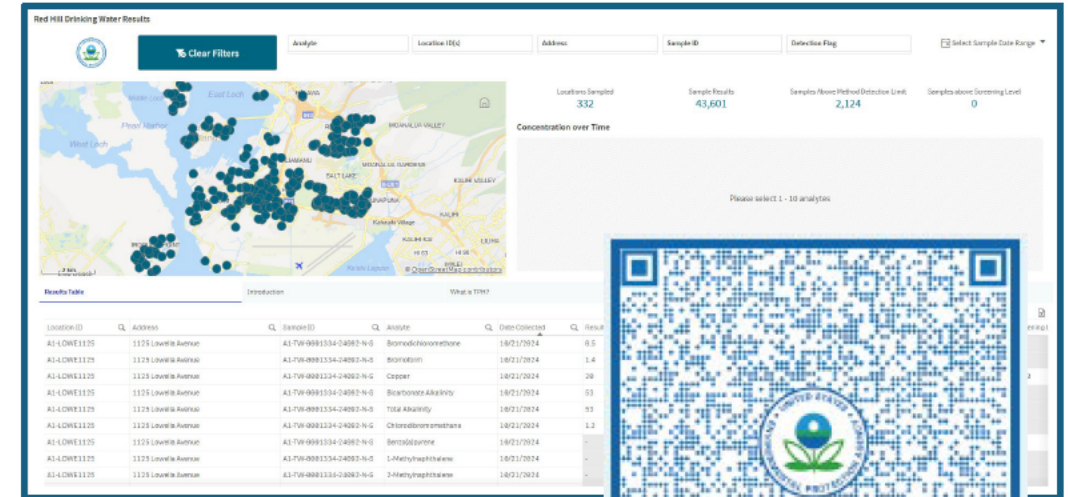
