

## GENERAL NOTES

### Presentation of Vital Statistics Data

#### Geographic Area

The City and County of Honolulu is abbreviated as Honolulu County or Hon. County.

#### Ethnicity

In all sections, the category "Hawaiian" also includes "Part-Hawaiian". Ethnicity is self-reported.

It should be noted that only one ethnicity is coded from the actual certificates. If more than one ethnicity is listed on the certificate, the following rules apply:

1. If Hawaiian is one of the multiple ethnicities listed, Part-Hawaiian is coded.
2. If a non-Caucasian ethnicity is listed with a Caucasian ethnicity, the non-Caucasian ethnicity is coded.
3. If there is more than one non-Caucasian ethnicity listed, the first one is coded.
4. If there is more than one Caucasian ethnicity listed, the first one is coded.

Ethnicity of the child is based on the ethnicity of the father. It is based on the ethnicity of the mother when the ethnicity of the father is unknown.

#### Cause of Death

The cause of death, as presented in the vital statistics section, is the underlying cause of death. All death certificates are coded according to rules developed by the National Center for Health Statistics using the International Classification of Diseases - 10th Edition. The rules are set to assist the coder in identifying the contributing as well as the underlying cause of death. The underlying cause may not be the immediate cause of death. Because of the change in coding in 1999, the cause of death data may not be exactly comparable to previous years'.

#### Death Rates

Death rates presented in the annual report, except where footnoted, are age-adjusted. Rates presented in annual reports prior to 1990, however, are crude rates.

#### Symbols

Whenever a table has many zero (0) entries, the symbol "-" is used instead of the "0". The symbol "-" is also used when an entry is not applicable.
