The City and County of Honolulu (CCH) Department of Environmental Services (ENV) prepared a Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) and the State of Hawai'i Department of Health (DOH) prepared a Record of Decision (ROD) on April 29, 2019 for the above proposed project.

**Project Description:**

The evaluation described in this Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) is focused on the upgrade of the Honouliuli WWTP required to comply with a First Amended Consent Decree. This FEIS for the Honouliuli WWTP is intended to inform the public and various stakeholders of potential impacts the project may have on the environment and has been prepared in accordance with the Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 343.

This project proposes to upgrade and expand the existing Honouliuli WWTP to provide secondary treatment and accommodate projected wastewater flows. The project may also result in a future increase in effluent discharged to Mamala Bay via the Barbers Point Deep Ocean Outfall.

Regardless of which treatment alternative is selected, additional improvements at the Honouliuli WWTP are proposed for the following: Central Laboratory, Ocean Team Facilities, Administration Building, Operations Building, Leeward Region Maintenance, Central Shops, Warehouse, truck wash, central supervisory control and data acquisition operations, septage receiving station, odor control, grounds keeping, janitorial service and security, and Honouliuli Water Recycling Facility. This FEIS also addresses the potential siting of new facilities at the Honouliuli WWTP to help consolidate island-wide wastewater system administrative services. Improvements to the Honouliuli major sewer conveyance system will be the subject of separate, subsequent environmental review documents.

A public comment period was held from *May 8, 2016 to June 22, 2016*.

Based on the information and recommendation that was provided by the CCH-ENV, the DOH concurs with the CCH-ENV's recommendation and approves the determination of the FEIS/ROD, in accordance with Chapter 343 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, Chapter 11-200 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules, 40 CFR §35.3140(b)(3)(ii) (for CWSRF projects). However, this decision may be reconsidered if a discovery of information concerning potential environmental impacts of the project occurs.

The documentation to support this decision will be on file at the DOH, Environmental Management Division, in Pearl City, Hawai'i, and is available for public review upon request.
