The Hawai'i Department of Health (DOH) has conducted a review of the proposed project for the County of Hawai'i in accordance with Hawai'i's State Environmental Review Process, Chapter 343 of the Hawai'i Revised Statues, Chapter 11-200 of the Hawai'i Administrative Rules, and 40 CFR §35.3140.

Project Description:

The project consists of replacing the existing Hale Hālā wai sewer force main located under the Hualālai Road from Ali'i Road to Kuakini Highway. The project will construct approximately 900 linear feet of new 12-inch diameter PVC pipe to serve as the new primary force main, replacing the existing line. The existing 12-inch diameter force main will be rehabilitated and serve as a back up to the proposed replacement. The new force main will run parallel to the existing at approximately the same depth. A sanitary sewer temporary flow bypass will be used during the installation of the force main.

DOH has determined that this project is eligible for an Exemption because this project involves repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, and equipment involving no expansion, change, or use beyond that previously existing; construction or replacement of minor structures accessory to existing facilities; demolition of structures within the footprint of the existing facility, except those structures located on any historic site as designated in the national register or Hawai'i register as provided for in the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, Public Law 89-665, 16 U.S.C. Section 470, as amended, or chapter 6E, HRS. Accordingly, the project is exempt from further substantive environmental review requirements under the above-stated authorities.

The documentation to support this decision will be on file at the DOH, Environmental Management Division, in Pearl City, Hawai'i, and is available for public review upon request.
