The City and County of Honolulu, Board of Water Supply ("County") prepared a Final Environmental Assessment (FEA) Determination of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) on December 16, 2024 for the above-proposed project.

Project Description:

The Proposed Action involves the construction of a new East Kapolei 215 R-1 3.0 MG reservoir; control (operations) building; and 16-inch transmission main extending along the East Kapolei 215 Reservoir site access road, Ho'opili Gateway Development, Farrington Highway, Kūalaka'i Parkway, and Kapolei Parkway. Upon completion of the project, R-1 use is expected to increase significantly by new demand from Ho'opili, University of Hawai'i (UH) West O'ahu, and Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) and having elevated storage to more readily provide R-1 water to existing BWS R-1 East system service areas. The Proposed Action will be on State, County, and Private lands.

A public comment period was held from April 23, 2024 to May 23, 2024 and there were eleven (11) comments received and addressed.

Based on the information and recommendation that was provided by the County, the State of Hawai'i, Department of Health (DOH) concurs with the County's recommendation and approves the FEA/FONSI, in accordance with Chapter 343 of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes, Chapter 11-200 of the Hawai'i Administrative Rules, 40 CFR §35.3140(b)(3)(i) (for CWSRF projects). However, this decision may be reconsidered if a discovery of information concerning the potential environmental impacts of the project occurs.

The documentation to support this decision will be on file at the DOH, Environmental Management Division, in Pearl City, Hawai'i, and is available for public review upon request.
