Effective October 1, 2016

Minimum Stocking Requirements Changes

Failure to maintain the required minimum inventory of WIC allowed foods may result in the disqualification of the vendor from WIC.

<p>Effective OCTOBER 1, 2016, only the following four (4) infant formulas may be purchased at WIC authorized grocery stores and only these UPC numbers will be paid by WIC. Stores should not use WIC shelf-talkers to identify other infant formulas. Stores should not program cash registers with any other infant formula UPC numbers as WIC allowed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">PARTICIPANTS WANTING TO PURCHASE OTHER INFANT FORMULA AT THE STORE SHOULD CONTACT THEIR CLINIC.</p>

VIOLATION	MAXIMUM NUMBER OF INCIDENTS	LENGTH OF DISQUALIFICATION
6. A pattern of failure to maintain the minimum variety and inventory of WIC foods including, but not limited to, the required quantities of Least Expensive Brand (LEB) items as declared.	Three (3)	Termination of MOA and six (6) month disqualification.
