INFANT FORMULA AND MINIMUM STOCKING REQUIREMENT CHANGES

Effective JANUARY 29, 2019, only the following four (4) infant formulas may be purchased at WIC authorized grocery stores and only these UPC numbers will be paid by WIC. Stores should not use WIC shelf talkers to identify other infant formulas. Stores should not program cash registers with any other infant formula UPC numbers as WIC allowed.

Please note: two (2) infant formulas have a minimum stocking requirement. Stores must carry THIRTY (30) cans of SIMILAC ADVANCE POWDER (12.4 ounce) UPC 070074-55958-2 and TEN (10) cans SIMILAC SOY ISOMIL POWDER (12.4 ounce) UPC 070074-55964-3 at all times.

Hawaii WIC vendors will no longer be required to stock GERBER GOOD START SOY as of January 29, 2019. To help stores to deplete stock of GERBER GOOD START SOY, Hawaii WIC will allow vendors to continue selling this brand. Please note, however, that WIC will cease to issue checks for GERBER GOOD START SOY at the end of January.

REMINDER:

Failure to maintain the minimum stocking requirements can result in disqualification from the WIC Program.
